

ORDINANCE NO. 348

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TIMES AND PLACES FOR ALL REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA CITY, OREGON; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 314

WHEREAS, it appears that the present established times for the meetings of the Common Council of the city of Columbia City, Oregon, are inconvenient to a majority of the members of the Common Council and the Mayor of the city, and the best interests of the city would be promoted by meeting at least twice a month hereafter upon Thursday evenings; now, therefore

THE CITY OF COLUMBIA CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Regular Meeting Times and Places. Hereafter and following the effective date of this ordinance, the regular meetings of the Common Council of the city of Columbia City, Oregon, shall be held as follows:

(a) The first regular meeting each month shall be held in said Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. upon the first Thursday of each and every month;

(b) The second regular meeting of each month shall be held in the Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. upon the third Thursday of each and every month.
