ODOT Right-of-Way Area - Entrance Sign: Leahnette said she's been in contact with the PUD regarding the lighting for the sign and flagpole, but due to vacations they haven't made any progress. She said Councilor Fromm has offered to install the flagpole. Sheila suggested a concrete platform. Micah will make sure the pole is installed according to proper US flag guidelines. Leahnette noted that the water connection needs to be installed for the irrigation system, which is currently temporarily connected to the hydrant.

Harvard Park: Members discussed the rock along Highway 30 across from the Mini Mart, and thought it would work well for the memorial plaque. Micah will check to see if the PW equipment can handle the rock. Micah will check with Jim Nelson of ODOT to find out if we can have the rock - possibly ODOT will offer to move it for us. Members discussed the placement of the rock in Harvard Park. Members thought it should be placed close to the park sign, with the plaque facing Sixth Street. Shannon said the drip system is in need of repair.

Public Works Wall: Leahnette said the empty containers need to be planted, and the drip system finished.

Datis Park: Jack said the sign is beginning to rust again.
