**Entrance Sign Site:** Shannon said the Public Works crew has installed a 2" water service to run the sprinkler system at the entrance sign site. She said they are planning the installation of the flag pole. Leahnette said the power will be pulled through by the CRPUD this week, and then the electrician will come back out to install the light fixtures. Leahnette said the Public Works crew is getting a cost estimate for using Caseron to control the weeds around the roses on the bank. Leahnette said Sally Ann Marson did an excellent job of removing the weeds from around the roses, and hopefully Public Works will be able to keep the weeds down during the season using a combination of Caseron and Round-Up.

**Pixie Park:** Stan said he plans to start working on removing the blackberries at Pixie Park.

**Harvard Park:** Leahnette said Ace Hardware donated a Clematis Armandii to Kathleen Devlin to plant near the porta-potty in Harvard Park for screening purposes. She said Kathleen is working on developing a final planting plan, and soliciting input, financial donations, and assistance with planting from her neighbors with adding more plants to screen the porta-potty from view.
