Eagle Scout Project: Committee Members discussed the new Eagle Scout project, which will involve the installation of approximately 210 feet of split rail fencing along the northern edge of the westerly section of paved bike path adjacent to McBride Creek.

Veterans Park:

Members discussed the grant application for Phase III improvements and decided upon the following project components:

- A monument providing a tribute to the family members of veterans;
- A POW/MIA monument;
- A fourth wall panel for veteran bricks;
- A plaque explaining the purpose of the hole that is drilled through the All American Veterans monument;
- Some durable and attractive trash containers;
- A drinking water fountain with a water bowl for dogs.

- Additional split rail fencing extending toward the west along the bike path.
- Additional landscaping materials to place behind the new split rail fencing sections (roses, bark dust, soil amendments, labor).

Harvard Park: Members agreed that the spinner should be removed to allow for better placement of the new see-saw.
