Chairman Marson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan: Members reviewed the current list of projects contained in the Five-Year Plan. It was the consensus of the Committee to make the following change to the Five-Year Plan during the upcoming 2019-20 budget process:

- Move The Strand Pavement Restoration Project from the 2018-19 budget cycle to the 2019-20 budget cycle due to the line work to be done along The Strand during the upcoming Safe Drinking Water Project;

Other Business: Public Works Superintendent Micah Rogers briefed the committee on the current status of crack seal work to be completed throughout the City. The work is tentatively scheduled for the spring of 2019.

Discussion was also led by Public Works Superintendent Rogers regarding street striping that was needed throughout the community, and the potential to explore the use of thermoplastic materials at key location sites in order to save the City future maintenance costs. Further financial research is needed with the feasibility explored in adding this project to the list of City Capital Improvement Projects.
