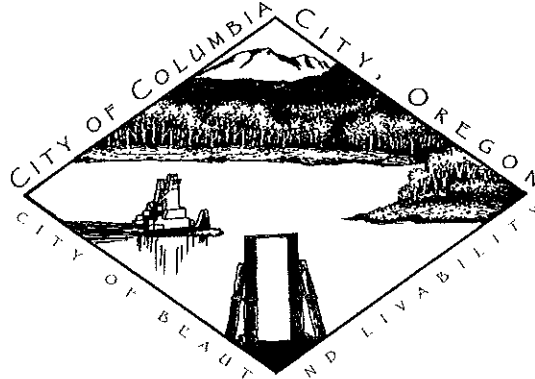

to the event or they may not have a reserved space available to them.

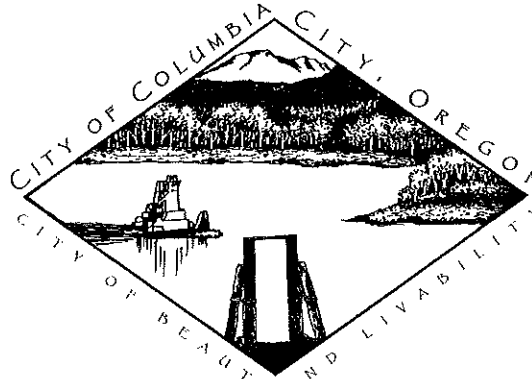
- July meeting date is being changed to July 13<sup>th</sup> so the committee has the opportunity to meet prior to the Prepare Fair and make changes as needed.

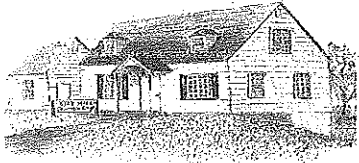
